INSTRUCTION MANUAL

CONGRATULATIONS!

You are about to embark on an exciting journey into the amazing natural world around you. Please read these instructions carefully so that you know how to get the most enjoyment from your new monocular set.

FOCUSING


Use the monocular with your dominant eye. Adjust the focus wheel until the image is sharp and clear.



TWIST-UP EYECUPS

Adjusting the eyecup is recommended for all users, especially glasses wearers to help eliminate the chances of seeing black spots when looking through the monocular lens.

1. Rotate the eye-cup to increase the eye-relief (distance between your eye and the lens) until you can comfortably see through the monocular without seeing any black spots.



PHONE ADAPTER

- 1. Place your phone in-between the sides of the mount and gently squeeze the sides of the mount until snug against your phone. Tighten the twist screw on the left to secure phone to mount.
- 2. Open the camera app on your phone. Slightly loosen the twist screw on the back of the mount just enough so that you can move your phone side to side. Adjust your phone side to side until your phone camera lines up with the camera hole on the phone adapter. NOTE- You may need to adjust your phone up or down in the mount by repeating step #1 so that your phone camera matches up perfectly with the camera hole on the phone adapter.



- 3. Place the phone adapter onto the monocular eyepiece. Make sure it is secure before letting go of the phone adapter.
- 4. Verify that your phone camera lines up perfectly with the camera hole in the phone adapter and that you can see the image through your monocular on your phone screen. Make the necessary adjustments by repeating steps #1 and #2 to adjust your phone left/right or up/down if needed.

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR MONOCULAR

- A. Keep the lens covers on the lenses when monocular is not in use.
- B. When wiping the lenses, use the lens cloth that comes with the monocular, or a soft, lint free cloth.
- C. To remove any remaining dirt or smudges, add one or two drops of isopropyl alcohol to the cloth.
- D. Store your monocular in a moisture-free area.
- E. Never attempt to clean your monocular internally or try to take it apart.
